NEW SCPA TICKETING FOR 2025

Tickets for all regular season events are now on sale! Our online ticket hub can be found at

scpa.live/tickets.

We expect high turnouts for most of our events, so we recommend taking advantage of the advance purchase option. In-person, day-of tickets may also be available (space permitting), but there is no guarantee.

Also, please note that seating is available on a first-come, first-served basis and is not guaranteed for general admission events. Spectators are *strongly* encouraged to be seated at least 15 minutes before a scheduled performance.

*Spectators are not allowed to enter the gym with tripods or monopods. The only exception to this is for those in possession of an SCPA issued Video Pass for specific use in the designated Video Area of the gym. Tripods and monopods are not permitted in the general seating area at any time.

*Out of consideration for the units, we ask that you remain in your seats during every performance and keep the aisles clear until the breaks between each performance.

*Without proper credentials issued by SCPA, all forms of video and sound recording of any performance are strictly prohibited. This is SCPA policy and is the only way to comply with United States copyright law. This policy is at the units' request and we ask that you please honor their wishes.

*Safety is paramount to all our performers. Therefore, the use of flash photography is strictly prohibited. Sales and/or public display of any photos from SCPA events are strictly prohibited.
